Historie vývoje WDL

- **Červen 2005:** knihovník LOC James H. navrhuje organizaci UNESCO vybudování World Digital Library.
- **Prosinec 2006:** UNESCO a LOC se spolupodílí na setkání expertů s klíčovými partnery ze všech regionů světa. Setkání expertů vede k rozhodnutí vybudovat pracovní skupinu, která by navrhla standardy a postupy pro výběr obsahu.
- **Říjen 2007:** LOC a pět partnerských institucí prezentuje prototyp budoucího WDL na zasedání UNESCO
- **Březen 2009:** WDL je zpřístupněno mezinárodní veřejnosti s obsahem o každém členském státě UNESCO.

Cíle projektu

- Podporovat mezinárodní a mezikulturní porozumění;
- Rozšiřovat objem a variace kulturního obsahu na internetu;
- Poskytnout zdroje učitelům, školákům a široké veřejnosti;
- Budovat partnerské instituce za účelem odstranění digitální propasti mezi zeměmi a uvnitř jich samotných



Title: **Codex Gigas**

Description

The Codex Gigas (or Devil's Bible) is a large 13th-century manuscript from Bohemia, one of the historical Czech lands. Renowned for its size and its striking full-page miniature of the devil, it contains a number of parts: the Old and New Testaments, his works of Josephus Flavius, Isidore of Seville's Etymologiae, the standard textbook for teaching medicine in the Middle Ages known as Ars medicinae (The art of medicine), the 13th-century Christian encyclopaedia (Chronica of the Bohemians) of Cosmas of Prague, and a calendar. Of special interest are the names that testify to the Bohemian origin of the manuscript and its eventual history. At the end of the 16th century, the Codex was incorporated into the collections of Landshut ruler Rudolph II. During the Swedish siege of Prague at the end of the Thirty Years' War (1648), the manuscript was taken as war booty and transferred to Stockholm.
